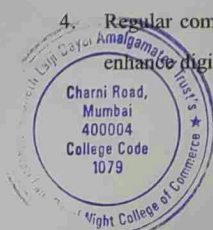

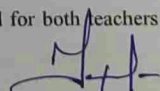
Key challenges and areas for improvement in the implementation of the e-governance system were also thoroughly discussed during the meeting.

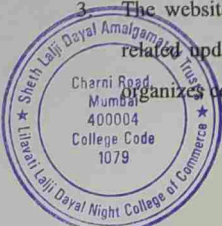
Key digital activities include:

1. Employee salaries are disbursed through NEFT/RTGS transfers, ensuring secure and efficient payment.
2. To maintain financial transparency, all scholarship payments and purchase transactions are executed via cashless methods, improving accountability in financial dealings.
3. The college employs Tally Cloud-based software for salary calculations and taxation processes. This software also helps generate financial reports and maintain books of accounts, streamlining audit procedures.
4. TDS Xpress software is used to manage TDS-related work, simplifying the generation of Form 16A for employees, ensuring compliance with tax regulations.

III. Student Admissions and Support:

To ensure the smooth operation of the admission process and to efficiently track admission inquiries, the college has implemented the following:

1. An online ERP portal and dedicated office email ID where students' data is recorded and all inquiries are managed in a centralized manner. This allows easy access to a student's complete profile in one place. The software also facilitates the issuance of bonafide and leaving certificates to students.
2. Online admission processes and support activities include publishing admission guidelines and schedules on the college website, document verification, fee payments, completing admission formalities, and offering counseling services to prospective students.
3. The website provides students with all essential information, including admission-related updates and other student-centric details. Additionally, the college regularly organizes computer literacy programs to enhance students' digital skills.
