

CRITERIA 4 – EXECUTIVE SUMMARY INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

LLDNCC college has quality infrastructure facilities. It creates an environment for effective teaching and learning.

HEI has qualitative infrastructure for Academics such as – ICT classrooms, Advanced Laboratories, Examination Room, Library, Internet – Wi-Fi facilities and staff room. Infrastructure for Administration includes waiting area, well equipped administration office, Principal's cabin, NAAC room and a placement cell.

The college has infrastructure for Extension activities such as – Auditorium, NSS room, DLLE room, Canteen, Playground (for outdoor games), Gymkhana for indoor games, Yoga centre, Cultural activity room.

HEI has qualitative infrastructure for central/common amenities such as – clean, spacious and hygienic washrooms, common room for Girls and Boys, First aid room, CCTV surveillance, fire extinguishers, notice boards, water coolers (for supply of filtered water) , Airy – spacious corridors and ample spacious campus.

Institute has about 14.62% of expenditure for infrastructure augmentation in 5 years assessment period. It shows the Institutions commitment for constantly upgrading the infrastructural facilities.

College undergoes regular financial audit and prepares income- expenses statement which is signed off by the Chartered Accountant.

HEI Library is a knowledge resource. It provides resources to support the curriculum and research for teachers and learners. The HEI Library is automated with E-Granthalay software.

The College Library has E-Resources available as free/open access method. There is no payment required for an e-resources subscription. It has E-Journals, E-magazines, E-books, E-databases, E-Encyclopedia etc., and many free resources for the benefit of all.

The library has about a 60 seating capacity, with approximately a footfall of 20% per day. An average of Rs. 65,000/- is spent on the procurement of these books.

HEI is perceptive for ICT facilities, its upgradation and qualitative internet services. It has an IT Lab with about 25 PCs, Projectors in the classrooms, with Internet connectivity. There are additional PCs in admin, exam rooms, staff room as well as the library. ITC facilities are updated, with about 100mbps bandwidth.

HEI provides 10:1 ratio for students: computers. It shows HEI commitment to enhance the students' critical thinking, problem solving abilities, and use effective communication facilities to improve their knowledge using technology.

HEI has always prioritized ICT facilities for smoother education, administration, record keeping and knowledge transfer.

On maintenance of ICT environment , physical facilities, academic support etc., HEI spends about 20% towards each head for its expenses.
